Caranthir, the fourth of the sons of Fëanor, was the harshest, and the quickest to anger; he was also called "Caranthir the Dark".

He spoke out harshly against Angrod, and was rebuked by Maedhros. He had little love for his cousins, the sons of Fingon.

Caranthir perished along with his brothers Celegorn and Curufin during the Second Kinslaying – the attack by the Sons of Fëanor on Menegoth to recover the Silmarils from Elven King Dior of Doriath.
