

Lenwë

The Nandor were Elves of Telerin descent, who left the Great Journey from Cuiviénen to Valinor as the Elves reached the Hithaeglar. Under their leader Lenwë a group of Teleri turned south along the Great River, and disappeared from written history.

Many years later a group of Nandor under Denethor, son of Lenwë, crossed the Ered Lûm into Ossiriand, which was after named Lindon, or Land of the Singers, after these elves. They became known as the Laiquendi or Green Elves.
